### Well Being Worker

Keewaytinook Okimakanak Board of Education (KOB) is currently seeking a Well Being Worker for their Elementary Second Level Services Department. Under the direction of the Elementary Services Manager, the Well Being Worker will work closely with KO First Nations' Mental Health/Wellness Workers to provide training and support. The Well-Being Worker would assist the KOB and KO Mental Health staff in identifying any service gaps and assist the KOB and KO staff in the development of programming and supports that would address these needs.

#### Responsibilities Include:

- Support Mental Health/Wellness programming for the KOB partner communities and programs
- Organize and provide training for the community Mental Health workers
- Work with other service providers and regional health organizations to develop a holistic approach to mental wellness including modern and traditional activities
- Work with KO member First Nation community educational programs
- Partner with KO to assist in identifying KO member First Nation priorities regarding mental health/wellness services in the community
- Travel extensively to KO communities

#### Qualifications and Skills:

- Qualifications in the field of Education, Social Work and/or Mental Health
- Experience working within First Nations' Mental Health and Counselling programs
- Good writing and documenting skills
- Good interpersonal skills and ability to facilitate workshops both in person and online
